## A HISTORY OF CARING FOR CHILDREN

The Wilmington community has a rich heritage of caring for sick and injured infants and children. In 1915, James Sprunt made a significant charitable gift to James Walker Hospital to build an annex in honor of his daughter, Marian, who died at age 13 of scarlet fever. The annex featured a 33-bed maternity and children's "ward", and was the first permanent facility dedicated to the care of sick babies and children in the area.

Under the legendary leadership of pediatrician J. Buren Sidbury, MD, the first Babies Hospital was established in 1920 at Wrightsville Beach. Dr. Sidbury began operations of the facility in a beach cottage with gifts totaling \$3,773 from the community. By 1928, Wilmington was well on its way to becoming the premier pediatric facility in North Carolina with the opening of a newly constructed Babies Hospital. By the 1950's, Babies Hospital was known throughout the country for providing the most advanced care for infants and children, training of pediatricians from around the nation and world, and pediatric research.

Unfortunately, private support for Babies Hospital could not keep pace with rising hospital costs and in 1978, Babies Hospital closed. Afterward, pediatric care was transferred to New Hanover Regional Medical Center.

Now, NHRMC is on the threshold of continuing the legacy of Babies Hospital and Dr. Sidbury with the construction of a new state-of-the-art Women's and Children's Center. This new 149-bed facility is designed to provide the highest standards of care with a focus on family, patient safety and advanced technology. The new Women's and Children's Center, like Babies Hospital before it, is destined to become one of the finest facilities in the country.

Dear Friends,


Webster's defines philanthropy as (n.) *an effort to promote human welfare*. I believe our community and New Hanover Regional Medical Center exemplify this definition in every way.

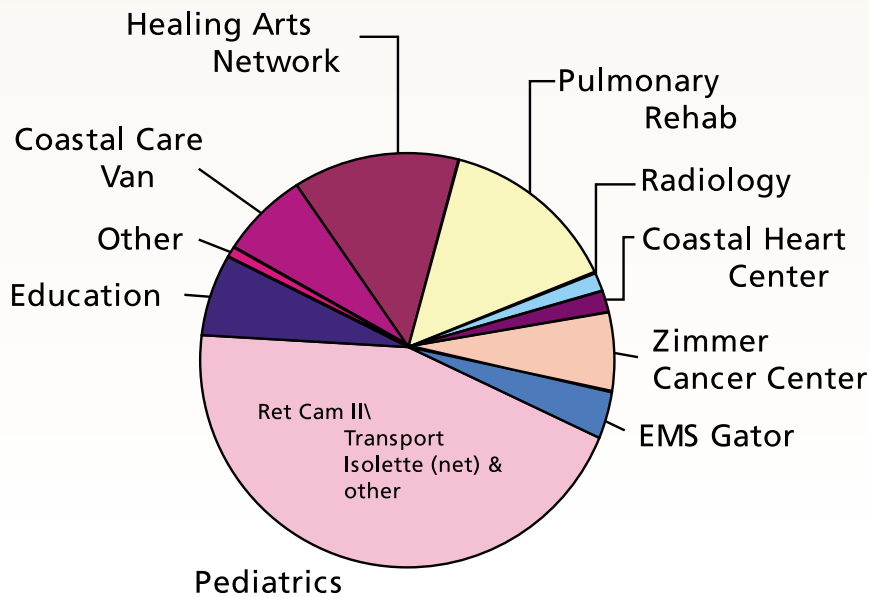

# 2006 ANNUAL COASTAL CLASSIC CELEBRITY GOLF TOURNAMENT

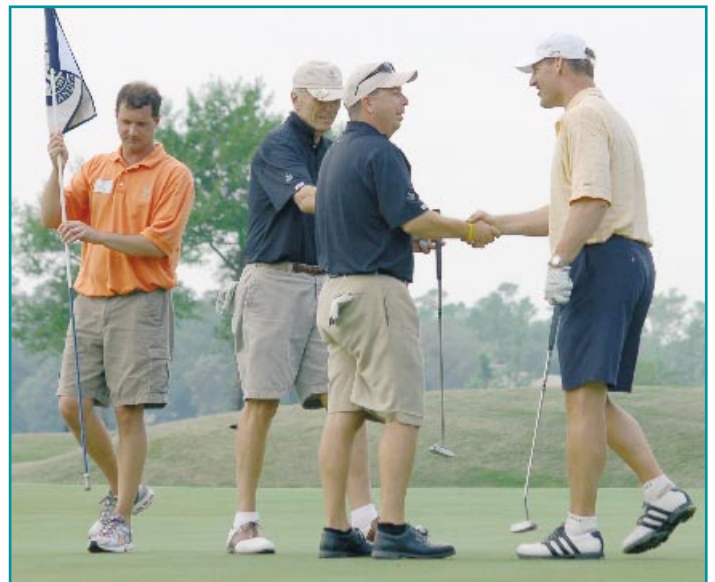
benefits NHRMC's Women's and Children's Center

Ms. Weller-Stargell and the Board of Directors of the Willie Stargell Foundation made the naming gift to help renovate the center to provide a comfortable and healing environment for patients and to help educate their families about renal disease and dialysis treatment.

## Gifts of Cash or Check

A gift by check is the simplest and most convenient way to support the programs and services you care about at New Hanover Regional Medical Center. If you wish for your gift to make an even larger impact, you may pledge it over a period of up to five years. If you itemize your tax deductions, a gift to the Foundation is fully deductible up to 50% of adjusted gross income and any excess may be carried forward for up to five years

## Appreciated Assets

A gift of appreciated assets such as stocks and bonds - that have been held for one year and a day, can provide not only an easy way to make a gift without interrupting your cash flow, but provide attractive tax advantages as well. A gift of appreciated assets avoids capital gains taxes and, in most cases, a charitable income tax deduction equal to the market value of the securities.

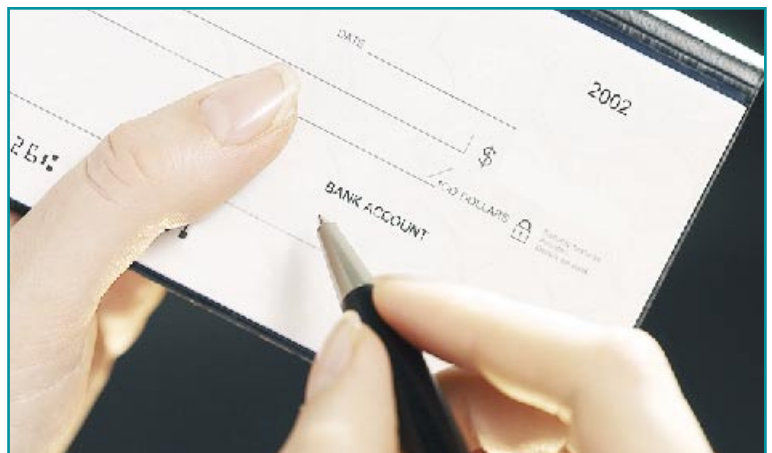
## Gifts of Real Estate

Gifts of commercial or residential real estate to the NHRMC Foundation may enable you and your family to provide a much larger gift than you may have originally thought possible.

A retained life estate allows individuals to donate their home to the Foundation and continue living there the remainder of their life. By making a gift of property while retaining residence, you would receive a charitable income tax deduction based on the value of the property and your life expectancy.

## A Life Income Gift

You may also consider a gift to the NHRMC Foundation that enables you to receive an income for life through a charitable remainder trust (CRT.) In addition to the satisfaction that comes from making a more noteworthy gift, a CRT offers benefits by providing an income stream for life for you and/or your spouse. A CRT also provides a charitable income tax deduction and most importantly, the opportunity to provide a significant gift to support an area within the hospital that is meaningful to you and your family.



## Gifts of Life Insurance

There are two primary ways you can use life insurance in your gift planning strategy. If your family is grown and you no longer need a paid-up policy, you can simply change the name of the owner and beneficiary to NHRMC Foundation. You may then take a charitable tax deduction for the policy's cash value.

Another way is to name NHRMC Foundation the owner and beneficiary of a new policy and then make the annual payments to the Foundation equal to the premium. The Foundation will then, in turn, make the payments on the policy. Your annual payment is fully tax deductible.

## Estate Gifts

One of the most meaningful ways you can support the mission and vision of New Hanover Regional Medical Center is a gift from your will or estate plan. An estate gift, coupled with other gift instruments, often enables you to

provide a legacy for your family through a naming opportunity in the Medical Center. This type of legacy allows you and your family the opportunity to designate the gift to a specific program or department at New Hanover Regional Medical Center that is truly meaningful to you.
