PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- Personal interview with the Volunteer Specialist
- Completed application packet
- Letter of recommendation/course requirements from a college professional (professor/counselor)
- Commitment to volunteer for six months per fiscal year
- Commitment to volunteer a minimum of once a week for a three-hour shift
- Attendance at a three-hour volunteer orientation class
- Completed background check and approval from the Special Police Services
- Results of a TB/PPD screening
- Complete specific hospital and departmental training
- Adhere to all hospital policy and procedures including the uniform and dress code standards

She will set up an interview and inform you about the availability of volunteer positions. During your interview, she will help you determine the best placement area to meet your needs as well as work out an acceptable schedule.
